SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR & STAFF \$2,050.00

Includes General and administrative expenses, securing, preparing, and filing necessary permits, certificates, authorizations and consents; clerical and record keeping. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremation, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains.

EMBALMING

\$750.00

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary however, if you select certain funeral arrangements such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.
